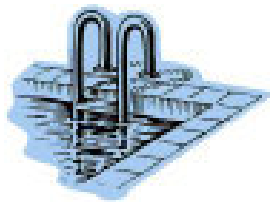

Guest passes can be purchased throughout the pool season. It is necessary to pre-order discounted guest pass cards (10 passes) by application or through the Hiddenbrook office during office hours (see office info at left). At anytime guests may enter accompanied by a member age 13 or older for the regular price of \$3 per guest to be paid to the guard upon entry. Payment must be made by check or money order only. Cash will not be accepted!

Be a good neighbor...

- Lawns must be **mowed** and weeded regularly. If you see a property in Hiddenbrook where grass exceeds 12", please call Fairfax county environmental services department at (703) 324-1937.

- **Keep sidewalks clear** by trimming overhanging trees and shrubs.

- Damaged or non-working **streetlights** should be reported to Miss Utility (800) 257-7777

- Problems with **storm drains** can be reported by calling (703) 934-2800.

- Damaged street name **signs** should be reported to the sign shop at (703) 934-2840. Contact VDOT for traffic sign maintaince at (703) 383-8368

- **Trashcans and re-cycle bins** cannot be in public view except on days of collection or the night before. Storage of these or other junk items in the front or side yards is not only unattractive but a violation of the Hiddenbrook covenants.

Please store trash, recyclables, outdoor toys, lawn equipment, car assessors, building materials, etc. inside your garage or shed or a place on your property not in view of the street or your neighbors.

the site of the future Snack Shack. We hope everyone has enjoyed the availability of snacks and drinks on the weekends.

As soon as we finish building the shack, we also will be open more often on weekdays. There will be a refrigerator/freezer in the shack, so in the coming weeks we'll be adding ice cream to the menu! Of course, that doesn't mean we won't break out the popular Sno Kones on occasion!

The shack will be run mostly on a cashless system. You can buy either a \$10 or \$20 concession card and that card stays in a file box at the table. When you want a snack, just give the concessions volunteer your name and membership number, then your card will be pulled and the amount purchased will be checked off.

The shack is being run completely by volunteers from the swim team, so every penny spent goes directly to benefiting the Hiddenbrook Hurricanes. This is a major fundraiser for the team, and the money earned goes to the costs of running the team. Currently we have 125 swimmers on the team representing about 80 families. Thank you for supporting the Hurricanes!
