Recycling is Now Single Stream—Keep it Together

Hiddenbrook residents are now able to put all recyclable materials into their collection bins without having to separate paper, cans, plastics, cardboard, metals and glass. Materials are collected in a single truck and taken to a local recycling facility for processing.

All plastic bottles, containers and lids (including jars, pails, buckets, and food-grade cups and tubs) are now recyclable. Please remember to clean them out first.

Be a good neighbor.....

-Lawns must be mowed and weeded regularly. If you see a property in Hiddenbrook where grass exceeds 12" please call Fairfax county environmental services department at (703) 324-1937 with the address.

-Keep sidewalks clear by trimming overhanging trees and shrubs.

- Damaged or non-working streetlights should be reported to Miss Utility (800) 257-7777

- Problems with storm drains can be reported by calling (703) 934-2800.

-Damaged street name signs should be reported to the sign shop (703) 934-2840. Contact VDOT for traffic sign maintenance at (703) 383-8368

-Trashcans and recycle bins cannot be in public view except on days of collection or the night before. Storage of these or other junk items in the front or side yards is not only unattractive but a violation of the Hiddenbrook covenants. Please store trash, recyclables, outdoor toys, lawn equipment, car assessors, building materials, etc. inside your garage or shed or a place on your property not in view of the street or your neighbors. And remember.....Hiddenbrook residents have free bulk and brush pick-up just call (703) 802-3322 to schedule.

-Clean up after your pets when walking them through the neighborhood.
